

We're excited to get back into league action this afternoon as we welcome Harpenden to our home stadium. Our recent performances have been strong.



Even though we lost to Cambridge United in the FA Cup, that match showcased one of our best showings this season against higher opposition —unfortunately, the score didn't reflect it. Our convincing win away at Colony Heath in the League Cup also highlighted our potential and produced a very welcomed clean sheet.

We're eager to build on this momentum and start increasing our points tally in the division. Currently, our position doesn't truly represent the players' abilities or the performances we've delivered so far. We genuinely believe we're on the brink of a winning streak that could propel us to greater heights in the league. 


Harpenden Town FC Women came top of the Division One North last season earning promotion to the Premier Division. They are 8th in the league to date on nine points.

If you've ever wondered what the odd-looking things on tall stands sitting near midfield are, those are the cameras. They use computer smarts (I refuse to call something so simple "AI") to track the ball and capture the action, with generally good but varying results. As an example of what can influence a model, consider a machine learning task to distinguish between photos of cats and dogs. The model did a great job on the training set but failed miserably on the test set. The problem? In the training data almost every cat wore a collar with a name tag dangling from it—the dogs didn't so it was easy to distinguish them.

A similar thing happened during the Covid lockdown. Matches were allowed to go forward after a while with no fans or media in the venue. That meant computer-controlled cameras. In one Italian match, the linesman on the near sideline (relative to the cameras) was bald. The light reflected such that the camera identified his head as the ball and followed it wherever it went. As a result, viewers saw very little of the action and the linesman got a lot more screen time than expected.

I'm immensely grateful that I get to watch the matches, even if they are on what used to be called "tape delay". That said, if you see a linesman that might district the camera, please ask them to put on a hat.
