We're excited to get back into league action this afternoon as we welcome Harpenden to our home stadium. Our recent performances have been strong.

Even though we lost to Cambridge United in the FA Cup, that match showcased one of our best showings this season against higher opposition —unfortunately, the score didn't reflect it. Our convincing win away at Colony Heath in the League Cup also highlighted our potential and produced a very welcomed clean sheet.

We're eager to build on this momentum and start increasing our points tally in the division. Currently, our position doesn't truly represent the players' abilities or the performances we've delivered so far. We genuinely believe we're on the brink of a winning streak that could propel us to greater heights in the league. We're also looking forward to the prospect of facing Hashtag reserves in the next round of the League Cup.

Today's match will be a challenge. Harpenden has had some solid results this season, and a few of their players are familiar to us. However, their performances have been somewhat inconsistent, likely due to squad availability issues—many teams have faced similar challenges, especially with players missing preseason or struggling to attend the early games due to holidays.





There's still plenty of football to be played, and we feel we're entering a good phase with players returning and looking fit and strong. We're starting to find our identity as a team, which is beginning to show on the pitch.

Brooke Halylock made a significant impact, scoring another hat trick—her second of the season in the Cup—and she's eager to add to her tally in the league, aiming to overcome an unusual statistic, all her 12 goals this season have been away from home.

This is despite hitting the woodwork several times. I'd say she's been unlucky, as we're probably in double figures for how many times she's struck the post at home. Today, she's eager to change that statistic.

We're heading into this match with confidence. The mood and intensity in training have been excellent, and both players and coaching staff are focused and optimistic about stringing together some positive results. We know we have some incredibly tough games ahead in the league, and every match has been competitive so far.

The quality of teams in our division has noticeably improved, just as the overall standard in women's football has risen. The younger players coming through have benefited from years of quality coaching, and it's starting to reflect in the standard across all tiers.

Living 5,000 miles away means that I often have to rely on social media to see match results and league tables. I appreciate that Atlético's crew update their Instagram feed when they can, but I'm also fortunate that I get to watch match videos on HUDL.

If you've ever wondered what the odd-looking things on tall stands sitting near midfield are, those are the cameras. They use computer smarts (I refuse to call something so simple "AI") to track the ball and capture the action, with generally good but varying results. As an example of what can influence a model, consider a machine learning task to distinguish between photos of cats and dogs. The model did a great job on the training set but failed miserably on the test set. The problem? In the training data almost every cat wore a collar with a name tag dangling from it—the dogs didn't so it was easy to distinguish them.

A similar thing happened during the Covid lockdown. Matches were allowed to go forward after a while with no fans or media in the venue. That meant computer-controlled cameras. In one Italian match, the linesman on the near sideline (relative to the cameras) was bald. The light reflected such that the camera identified his head as the ball and followed it wherever it went. As a result, viewers saw very little of the action and the linesman got a lot more screen time than expected.

I'm immensely grateful that I get to watch the matches, even if they are on what used to be called "tape delay". That said, if you see a linesman that might distract the camera, please ask them to put on a hat.
