A name change to C&K Basildon followed in 2007/08.

The 2019/20 campaign saw the first team in the FA Women's National League Division One South. Under a new name, AFC Basildon.

I like our chances, but there's no sense of relief from having been drawn against a club a league down.

We've seen some interesting developments regarding soccer (sorry) in the United States over the past month. Perhaps the biggest change, and one that I believe is both for the good and long overdue, is that Major League Soccer will change from the current spring-to-winter schedule to a summer-to-spring schedule starting in 2027. Aligning the MLS schedule with that of the civilized footballing world will help in the transfer market and perhaps allow other changes that are yet to be determined.

What the powers-that-be don't seem willing to do is to move away from the playoff system, which is baked into American culture, or instituting promotion and relegation. I personally would prefer to have the table be the table at the end of the season, but as I've said before I don't think promotion and relegation could work in the States. Franchise ownership, as opposed to a tradition of local ownership and clubs named after places, would be too much of a change to be tolerated at present.
