### FIRST TEAM MANAGER

This Sunday, we welcome Enfield at our home ground for our final home match of the year.

After a remarkable unbeaten streak that saw us lose just twice in 12 games, we now face the challenge of bouncing back from two consecutive defeats. I was proud to receive the Manager of the Month award for October, but we must address our recent defensive lapses, which have cost us dearly. Last week, we suffered a disappointing exit from the league cup, losing 5-2 in a game where we controlled much of the possession.

The week before, we lost 2-1 to Haringey Borough in a closely contested league match, despite again having the majority of the ball. Injuries have prevented us from fielding the same starting eleven regularly, but this presents an opportunity for others to step up. The mood in the camp is positive, and training sessions have remained intense. The players understand that we're entering a critical phase of the season. As the weather changes, every point becomes hard-fought. We need to be aware that our opponents may adjust their tactics to counter us.

If we aspire to reach the heights we believe we can, we must start accumulating points again. Last week, despite conceding five goals, we created six or seven clear-cut chances that we failed to convert. We took a calculated risk by resting a few players with minor injuries, prioritizing the league over the cup. In hindsight, those decisions may not have worked in our favour on the day however we need to consider the bigger picture.

We're confident heading into this match and look forward to showcasing our skills at home. We aim to be aggressive and take the initiative, striving for a win in what promises to be an entertaining clash.

As a writer and online training course developer I spend a lot of time deciding which concepts and techniques I want to teach and, as important, figuring out the best way to teach them.
